This year once again in conjunction with Bord Bia we are organising a competition and Food Academy for Secondary Schools. This competition will create awareness among students of the success of the Irish Food Industry and the nutritional benefits of Quality Irish Food .Bord Bia has established the Quality Mark through which it approves and promotes quality Irish Food in the retail sector.

For 2019 students at Junior and Senior Level are invited to submit a study on the following topic

## \*The role of Bord Bia in the promotion of Irish Food and the Quality Mark .

#### **Competition Criteria for all students**

The following information should be included in student's research:

- 1. The setting up and role of **Bord Bia**
- 2. Understanding of the **QUALITY MARK**, carry out research on how Bord Bia quality mark differs from other marks such as Love Irish Food <u>or</u> research the whole cycle of the Quality Mark from Farmer to Consumer.
- 3. Plan a Menu for <u>Healthy and Balanced Meals</u> incorporating foods with the Quality Mark for a day for a family, include recipes /method of making for one of the meals.
- 4. Give details of the **<u>Nutritional Value</u>** of the meal ,cooking storage, allergens etc
- 5. Create a <u>Newsletter /Video or a Slide Show which could be used by Bord Bia</u> in schools to promote and increase sales of Quality Assured Foods.

### 1 Junior Cycle - 1st & 2nd Year Students:

### 2 Senior Cycle -Transition & 5th Year student
